Contribution to the National Kidney Foundation



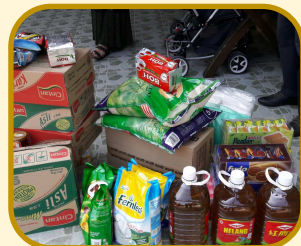
